Context

Small streams make great rivers, they say!

There is a segment of the population in every country in the world which lives in extreme poverty and survives only with the help of people of goodwill.

In the poor countries of sub-Saharan Africa, the percentage of this category of population is even higher and basic needs appear more drastic and difficult to meet. Some of these countries seem to have resigned from their sovereign missions of public service of social protection and aid to the poor.

However, there are undeniably on all continents, men, women, associations and even institutions or companies which draw from their reserve of compassion, unsuspected resources to ennoble their lives and their activities by investing in charitable actions.

These two worlds, although evolving in parallel, strongly feel the need to meet for solidarity barter.

The non-governmental organization Global Solidarity for Human Dignity (GSfHD) offers itself as a bridge to link these two universes in order to carry out actions that aim not only to collect the superfluous of some to meet the needs of others, but also to identify, organize and present these needs to potential interlocutors.

The United States, France, Europe, Canada and Asia are privileged places, secular markets where many support, aid and assistance initiatives of all kinds thrive. This Global Solidarity operation also dreams of finding fertile land to cultivate a new garden of a thousand hopes.

This document describes our ambition while identifying the priority areas of intervention as well as the envisaged strategy for the implementation of this operation.

Priority areas of intervention

Our actions are essentially aimed at the well-being of the child in his life course. Thus, everything that has to do with his social and school environment interests us. The following points specify our intentions:

- 1. Collection of food supplies for the benefit of two thousand (2000) orphan schoolchildren and students, disabled or from very poor families in Benin;
- **2.** Collection of clothes for the benefit of two thousand (2000) orphan schoolchildren and students, disabled or from very poor families in Benin;

- **3.** Collection of school Supplies and books for the benefit of two thousand (2000) orphan schoolchildren and students, disabled or from very poor families in Benin;
- **4.** Collection of new, reformed or used IT hardware and computer equipment (computers, tablets, printers and others) for the benefit of two thousand (2000) orphan schoolchildren and students, disabled or from very poor families in Benin;
- **5.** Collection of toys for the benefit of two thousand (2000) orphan schoolchildren and students, disabled or from very poor families in Benin;
- **6.** Collection of new, reformed and used sports materials and equipment (shoes, jerseys, various balls and others) for the benefit of two thousand (2000) orphan schoolchildren and students, disabled or from very poor families in Benin;
- **7.** Provision of light vehicles, field vehicles; new or used minibuses for the transport of orphan schoolchildren and students, disabled as well as to ensure blood donation campaigns for the benefit of hospitals;
- **8.** Collection of tricycles and other equipment for the benefit of disabled schoolchildren and students in schools and colleges in Benin;
- **9.** Collection of medical equipment and devices for the benefit of health centers and district hospitals and rural remote of Benin and West Africa;
- **10.** Search for sponsors to offer complete assistance and life monitoring to two thousand (2000) two thousand (2000) orphan schoolchildren and students, disabled or from very poor families in Benin
- **11.** Organization of fairground medical consultation missions and surgical operations in certain regions of Benin and West Africa not served by public hospitals;
- **12.** Establishment of twining between some towns and schools in poor regions of Benin and West Africa:
- **13.** Collection of new or used play equipment and materials to create and run amusement and leisure parks for the benefit of young schoolchildren and orphans, disabled or from poor families in Benin and Africa West.

Operating Mode

Our advocacy and mobilization actions aim to sensitize, all over the world, natural persons or groups of individuals of good will, associations, foundations and philanthropic institutions or even for-profit companies to invite them to dedicate a small part of their surplus resource in order to bring a little happiness in the life of one or more disabled orphan children or from very poor families on the other side of the world, in Benin or in West Africa.

Did you know that:

- 10 Euros can offer 13 meals to an orphan child!
- 20 Euros would be enough to make a schoolboy's clothes for one entire school year!
- Less than 50 euros for school supplies!
- Etc.
